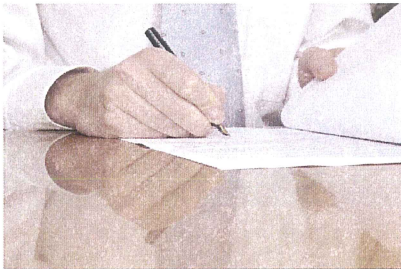

CLEANUP PRIVATIZATION COMES TO NEW JERSEY



Governor John Corzine recently signed New Jersey's law to establish a licensing program for site remediation professionals, and to change the laws concerning site remediation.

Governor John Corzine recently signed New Jersey's law to establish a licensing program for site remediation professionals, and to change the laws concerning site remediation.

The law:

- Establishes a site remediation professional licensing board.
- Establishes the responsibilities of Licensed Site Remediation Professionals (LSRPs).
- Establishes a temporary site remediation professional license program.
- Sets up procedures and a program to audit the work of LSRPs.
- Describes how covenants not to sue issued when remediation is complete can still be obtained under the newly privatized program.

In addition to the above, presumptive remedies are to be established by DEP for certain properties, including residential schools and daycare properties. Also, mandatory timeframes are established in the new law for responsible parties to conduct, implement and complete remediation activities.

The program for temporary licensing of licensed site remediation professionals is to be setup within 90 days. Formal DEP reviews of most site investigation remediations, will no longer be required. For those cases which are to be conducted by LSRPs, the LSRP must be employed by the responsible party, within three years.

RT looks forward to this new day in the New Jersey Site Remediation Program, when projects will move forward more efficiently and expeditiously. RT has operated through partners in a number of states with privatized programs including Ohio, Massachusetts, and Connecticut, for more than a decade. RT anticipates that a number of our staff will qualify as Licensed Site Remediation Professionals, and, we have already set up a project approach to assure high levels of internal performance and peer reviews for every New Jersey project, as DEP reviews will no longer be conducted on most remediation sites in the Garden State.
