The Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection has also examined its Statewide Health Standards as part of routine reviews of its regulatory programs. A

number of Statewide Health Standards have been modified to be less stringent, due to changes in the average body weight (which when calculated as a basis for the Standards are set, is appropriately revised from time to time). For some PAH compounds, cleanup standards are now less stringent, but there are no significant changes in the Statewide Health Standards for arsenic or benzo(a)ovrene.
