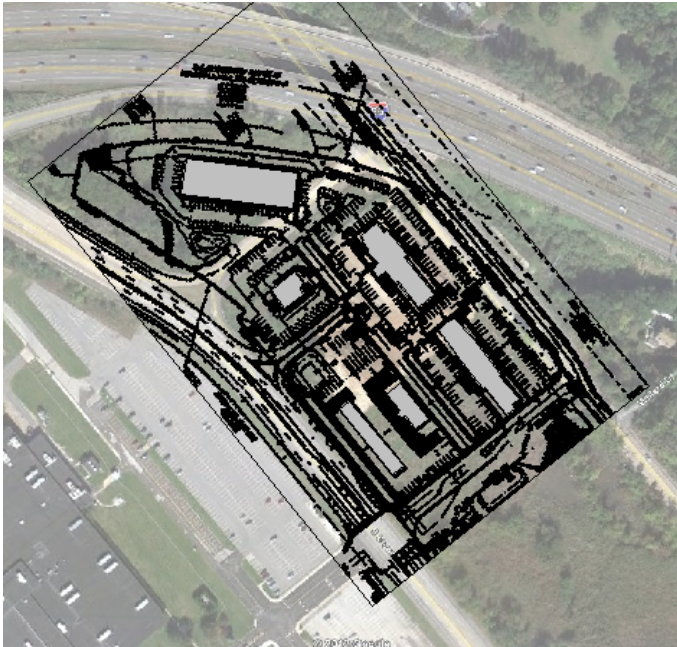




[HOTEL - RETAIL REDEVELOPMENT GOES FORWARD NEAR PHILADELPHIA AIRPORT](#)



MGM Ridley Parking, L.P. broke ground in September on Ridley Square on Pa. 291 in Ridley Township, at the site of a former wastewater-treatment facility. MGM has signed up a 78-room Microtel Inn & Suites by Wyndham, a Royal Farms gas station/convenience store, and a Wendy's restaurant. Subsidies include a \$2.5 million Redevelopment Assistance Capital Program state matching grant and a \$1.25 million Infrastructure Development Program grant.

The first phase will cost \$20 million-plus and create about 239 construction jobs, then 156 store and hotel jobs when it is finished in May, said project manager Remington Group.
