



## SPILL PREVENTION RESPONSE PLANS IN WEST VIRGINIA

- Are you preparing yours?

It is estimated that 10,000 tanks in West Virginia will be required to prepare and maintain adequate Spill Prevention Response Plans prepared by Professional Engineers, in order to continue to operate their tanks after October 1, 2014. Secondary containment is required to control any releases, and tank operators will be required to implement systems for early detection of releases. Provisions will be needed to provide immediate reporting of releases, among other requirements.
