Press Release

Today is the day by which those responsible for investigation and remediation of contaminated sites in New Jersey have to retain a Licensed Site Remediation Professional (LSRP). RT already has dozens of LSRP sites throughout the state as shown in the inset map.

With New Jersey's new program under the Site Remediation Reform Act, there has been an orderly process of retaining LSRPs, but individuals and companies who do not retain an LSRP, and are on the list of 9,000 to 10,000 of the New Jersey's contaminated sites which have not been remediated, will be in violation of the law if they do not retain a Licensed Site Remediation Professional promptly.

RT has been fortunate enough to already move a significant number of sites through the new process and our President, as LSRP, has issued a substantial number of Response Action Outcome statements, which confer a Covenant Not to Sue from the state on the site or area of concern involved. This means that remediation is complete and that contamination at the site is addressed. Sites we have completed involve underground storage tank releases, sites with historic fill, background conditions, and groundwater releases at drycleaner sites. The good news is that the New Jersey Site Remediation Program is now efficient, reasonably flexible, and focused on results, and the standards that one must reach are clear. There are also a series of guidance documents, and DEP officials are available for consultation, so past fears about lengthy and costly remediation processes that cost more than necessary, are unfounded.
